Step 1: Pinch barb and slide beads onto hook, white in front. Place hook in Vise vertically.



Step 2: Wrap a small thread pad on bend of hook for an attachment point for the Stretch Magic.



Step 3: Attach the two strands with three to four firm wraps over the top and three turns directly in front. Maintain good tension on the thread.



Step 4: Reposition the hook into normal horizontal tying position. Spiral the thread forward to the bead and make several wraps to secure the beads. Leave as much hook exposed as possible.



Step 5: Wrap the two strands forward side by side with slight tension and secure behind the bead.

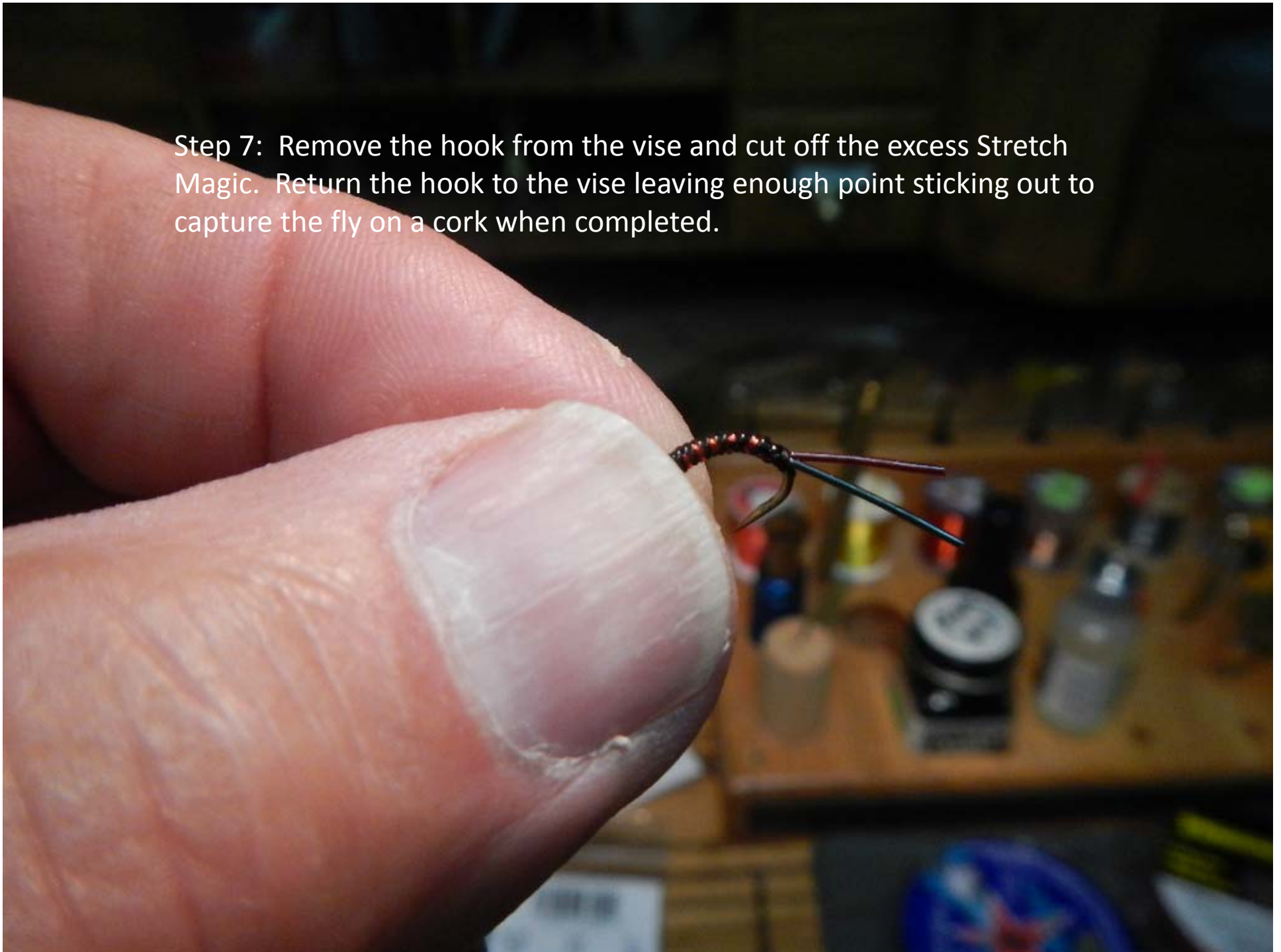




Step 6: Cut off excess Stretch Magic and wrap a good thorax behind the bead. Remember that the red bead makes up part of the thorax so the thread portion does not need to be too large.



Step 7: Remove the hook from the vise and cut off the excess Stretch Magic. Return the hook to the vise leaving enough point sticking out to capture the fly on a cork when completed.



Step 8: Cover the thread with head cement and remove with a wine cork to dry. There is no need to apply anything to the Stretch Magic.
