BASICS KEEP YOUR EYES OPEN! WHAT ARE FISH OR OSPREY DOING?

4x LEADER 5x TIPPET DROPPER (18 - 24") PONTOON BOAT/DRIFT BOAT

FULL SINK – INTERMEDIATE – FLOATING TAKE ALL WITH YOU IF POSSIBLE

WHERE

3 WEED BEDS – MOUND – WHITE SLIDE – CLIFFS (SEE MAP)

FLIES DRY SIZE 12 -14 UPPER FLY DROPPER 14 - 18

CALEBAETIS DUNS, EMERGERS, CRIPPLES, & SPINNERS (size 12-14)

BLUE WING OLIVE ADAMS MARCH BROWNS PURPLE HAZE PMD

GRIFFITHS GNAT & MIDGE DUNS (size 16-18) BLACK ANTS BLACK CADDIS

WET FLIES SIZE 8 – 16 (FLASH & MULTICOLOR PREFERRED)

WOLLY BUGGERS LEECHES (BOOBY FLIES per chan & Rowley?) MINI LEECH

CAB NYMPHS LIGHTENING BUG PRINCES ZUGBUG HARES EAR TEENY NYMPH

TECHNIQUE

FIND A HATCH (pockets N & S shores) OTHERWISE- FULL SINK MAYBE INTERMEDIATE

CHRONOMIDS (RED, BLACK, GREEN, BLUE OR CHROME) USE FULL SINK IN MIDSUMMER 30'

RETRIEVE - WET- VARY FROM VERY SLOW TO FAST NATURAL MOVEMENT IF POSSIBLE

DRY- STATIONARY, TWITCHES, PULLS & SUBSURFACE (3-4")

HOOKING - MINIMIZE LIFTING ROD – use strip to set hook WATCH FOR SLACK

CONDITIONS

WATER TEMP WIND – changes everything TURNOVER IMPACT - minimal
